3 B. In the absence of fraud, bad faith, reckless disregard for
4 the truth, or actual malice, no person, insurer, or agent of an
5 insurer shall be liable for damages in a civil action or subject to
6 criminal prosecution for supplying information about suspected
7 insurance fraud to the Anti-Fraud Division of the Insurance
8 Department, the Workers' Compensation and Insurance Fraud Unit of
9 the Office of the Attorney General or any other agency involved in
10 the investigation or prosecution of suspected insurance fraud. The
11 immunity provided in this subsection shall not extend to any person,
12 insurer, or agent of an insurer for communications or publications
13 about suspected insurance fraud to any other person or entity.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
