

1 2. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
2 Services;

3 3. The Department of Corrections;

4 4. The Department of Transportation; and

5 5. The Office of Juvenile Affairs.

6 B. State employees who are affected by violent or traumatic
7 events that occur in the workplace shall have the option to refuse
8 the debriefing and counseling services offered pursuant to
9 subsection A of this section.

10 C. The Director of the Office of State Finance shall promulgate
11 rules to implement the provisions of this section which, at a
12 minimum, shall specify the types of events which shall qualify state
13 employees for debriefing and counseling services.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
