



1 a licensed allopathic or osteopathic physician as available onsite  
2 at the scene of the disaster. The physician assistant shall only  
3 render medical services within the physician assistant's scope of  
4 practice.

5 B. Any licensed allopathic or osteopathic physician or  
6 physician assistant who provides care onsite in a declared emergency  
7 pursuant to subsection A of this section shall not be liable for  
8 damages as a result of any acts or omissions except for committing  
9 gross negligence or willful or wanton wrongs in rendering care.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
