11 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
12 directing Department to make certain evaluation;
13 directing Department to assist certain persons in
14 specified manner; providing for codification; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2010 of Title 56, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Department of Human Services shall:

21 1. In consultation with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority,
22 evaluate all persons currently in the state Medicaid program who are
23 categorically eligible as aged, blind or disabled individuals to
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1 determine if such persons are dually eligible for the Medicare
2 program; and

3 2. Evaluate all persons in the state who apply and qualify for
4 the state Medicaid program as an aged, blind, or disabled individual
5 to determine if such persons are dually eligible for the Medicare
6 program.

7 B. If the Department determines that individuals are dually
8 eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare, the Department shall take
9 all necessary steps to assist such persons in enrolling in the
10 Medicare program in addition to the state Medicaid program.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
