

1 aid. As used in this section "laser sighting device" means any
2 artificial light or any form that casts or reflects a beam of light
3 onto or otherwise illuminates wildlife.

4 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
5 apply to persons who are disabled as provided for in this subsection
6 and as certified by a physician licensed in this state or any state
7 which borders this state, if the person is hunting on private
8 property and is accompanied by a licensed hunter. For purposes of
9 this section a person is disabled if the person is permanently
10 statutorily/legally blind as defined by the Social Security
11 Administration or is afflicted with paraplegia or quadriplegia.

12 C. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
13 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
