11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2011, Section 14-116, which relates to size, weight
13 and load; specifying information to be contained on
14 certain permits; prohibiting use of permit by certain
15 vehicles; requiring permittee to update information;
16 providing for certain rules; providing an effective
17 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 14-116, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 14-116. A. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
22 charge a minimum permit fee of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) for any permit
23 issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 14-101 et seq. of this
24 title. In addition to the permit fee, the Commissioner shall charge

1 a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each thousand pounds in excess of
2 the legal load limit. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
3 establish any necessary rules for collecting the fees.

4 B. The Department of Public Safety is authorized to establish
5 an escrow account system for the payment of permit fees. Authorized
6 motor carriers meeting established credit requirements may
7 participate in the escrow account system for permits purchased from
8 all size and weight permit offices in this state. Carriers not
9 choosing to participate in the escrow account system shall be
10 required to make payment of the required fee or fees upon purchase
11 of each permit as required by law. All monies collected through the
12 escrow account system shall be deposited to a special account of the
13 Department of Public Safety and placed in the custody of the State
14 Treasurer. Proceeds from permits purchased using the escrow account
15 system shall be distributed as provided for in subsection G of this
16 section. However, fees collected through such accounts for the
17 electronic transmission, transfer or delivery of permits, as
18 provided for in Section 14-118 of this title, shall be credited to
19 the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

20 C. 1. Application for permits shall be made a reasonable time
21 in advance of the expected time of movement of such vehicles. For
22 emergencies affecting the health or safety of persons or a
23 community, permits may be issued for immediate movement.

1 2. Size and weight permit offices in all districts where
2 applicable shall issue permits to authorize carriers by telephone
3 during weekdays.

4 3. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall develop a system for
5 provisional permits for authorized carriers which may be used in
6 lieu of a regular permit for the movement of oversize and overweight
7 loads when issued an authorization number by the Department of
8 Public Safety. Such provisional permits shall include date of
9 movement, general load description, estimated weight, oversize
10 notation, route of travel, truck or truck-tractor license number,
11 and permit authorization number.

12 D. No overweight permit shall be valid until all license taxes
13 due the State of Oklahoma have been paid.

14 E. No permit violation shall be deemed to have occurred when an
15 oversize or overweight movement is made pursuant to a permit whose
16 stated weight or size exceeds the actual load.

17 F. Any permit issued for a truck or truck-tractor operating in
18 combination with a trailer or a semitrailer shall contain only the
19 license plate number for the truck or truck-tractor if the permittee
20 provides to the Department a list containing the license plate
21 number, and such other information as the Department may prescribe
22 by rule, for each trailer or semitrailer which may be used for
23 movement with the permit. When the permittee provides the list

1 described in this subsection, the license plate number for any
2 trailer or semitrailer to be moved with the permit shall not be
3 included on the permit; provided, a trailer or semitrailer which is
4 not on the list shall not be authorized to be used for movement with
5 the permit. It shall be the responsibility of the permittee to
6 ensure the list provided to the Department is maintained and updated
7 with any fleet changes. The Department shall adopt any rules deemed
8 necessary to administer the provisions of this subsection.

9 G. The first deliverer of motor vehicles designated truck
10 carriers or well service carriers manufactured in Oklahoma shall not
11 be required to purchase an overweight permit when being delivered to
12 the first purchaser.

13 ~~G.~~ H. Except as provided in Section 4 14-122 of this ~~act~~ title,
14 the first One Million Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Dollars
15 (\$1,216,000.00) of proceeds from both the permit fees and the
16 overweight permit fees imposed pursuant to subsection A of this
17 section collected monthly shall be apportioned as provided in
18 Section 1104 of this title. All proceeds collected from both the
19 permit fees and the overweight permit fees imposed pursuant to
20 subsection A of this section in excess of One Million Two Hundred
21 Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$1,216,000.00) shall be deposited in the
22 Weigh Station Improvement Revolving Fund as provided in Section 1167
23 of this title for the purpose set forth in that section and may be

1 used for motor carrier permitting systems and motor carrier safety
2 and enforcement.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
