18 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3226.1 of Title 70, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall adopt a
23 policy which allows a student to enroll in an institution within The

1 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and be eligible for
2 resident tuition if the student:

3 1. Satisfies admission standards as determined by the Oklahoma
4 State Regents for Higher Education for the appropriate type of
5 institution and has secured admission to, and enrolled in, an
6 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education
7 prior to July 1, 2014;

8 2. Earned a high school diploma from a public school district
9 in this state; and

10 3. Was an Oklahoma resident at the time the student received a
11 high school diploma.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
