4 Governmental Tort Claims Act for any act or omission of an employee
5 acting outside the scope of his or her employment.

6 B. The liability of the state or political subdivision under
7 ~~this act~~ The Governmental Tort Claims Act shall be exclusive and in
8 place of all other liability of the state, a political subdivision
9 or employee at common law or otherwise.

10 C. The Governmental Tort Claims Act shall not be construed to
11 limit the liability of the state or a political subdivision for any
12 adverse personnel action taken against an employee for refusal to
13 attend a religious event or an event sponsored by a religious
14 organization; provided, the provisions of this subsection shall not
15 apply if the employee was directed to be in attendance in the
16 exercise of official duties.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
