11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-323A, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 3-323A. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance  
14 Abuse Services shall promulgate rules and standards for  
15 certification of a facility or organization that desires to be  
16 certified as a ~~"Mental Illness Service Program"~~ an "Outpatient  
17 Mental Health Treatment Organization".

18 B. Applications for certification as a ~~mental illness service~~  
19 ~~program~~ an outpatient mental health treatment organization shall be  
20 made to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
21 on prescribed forms. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental  
22 Health and Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board,  
23 may certify mental illness service programs for a period of three  
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1 (3) years, subject to renewal as provided in the rules promulgated  
2 by the Board.

3 C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
4 is authorized to establish and collect certification and renewal  
5 fees for certification of ~~mental illness service programs~~ outpatient  
6 mental health treatment organizations as provided in Section 3-324  
7 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 D. ~~A certified mental illness service program~~ An outpatient  
9 mental health treatment organization shall comply with standards  
10 adopted by the Board. Such standards shall be in compliance with:

11 1. The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare  
12 Organizations;

13 2. The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation  
14 Facilities; or

15 3. Approved medical and professional standards as determined by  
16 the Board.

17 E. The following shall be exempt from certification  
18 requirements as an outpatient mental health treatment organization:

19 1. Hospitals licensed by the State Department of Health; and

20 2. Individual persons in private practice as licensed  
21 physicians, licensed psychologists, licensed social workers,  
22 registered nurses, licensed professional counselors, licensed  
23 marriage and family therapists, licensed behavioral practitioners,  
24 individual members of the clergy, and certified alcohol or drug

1 abuse counselors. The exemption provided for under this paragraph  
2 shall apply only to individual professional persons in their private  
3 practice and not to any treatment facility operated by the person.

4 F. Failure to comply with rules and standards promulgated by  
5 the Board shall be grounds for revocation, suspension or nonrenewal  
6 of certification.

7 SECTION 3. REPEALER 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-106, is  
8 hereby repealed.

9 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
