2 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized

4 3. During participation in or in preparation for a military  
5 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma  
6 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active  
7 military forces;

8 4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized  
9 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as

13 6. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
14 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title~~  
15 or any legislative enactment regarding the use, ownership and  
16 control of firearms; or

17 7. When living in a motor home or recreational vehicle which  
18 has been modified as a semipermanent or permanent residence and not  
19 in transport.

20 B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,  
21 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun  
22 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to  
23 the following conditions:

1 1. When going to or from the person's private residence or  
2 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to  
3 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or  
4 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith,  
5 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target  
6 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms  
7 activity or event and while in such places; or

8 2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma  
9 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title.~~

10 C. For purposes of subsection A of this section, "motor home or  
11 recreational vehicle" means a vehicle that is manufactured,  
12 constructed or equipped permanently as a self-propelled home or  
13 living quarters, kitchen and sleeping quarters, capable of being  
14 operated on the highways, but shall not include vehicles equipped  
15 with a camper.

16 ~~C.~~ D. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to  
17 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,  
18 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns  
19 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the  
20 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
