

1 Abuse Services, unless evidence of drug and/or alcohol use occurring
2 post-graduation is acquired by the Department of Public Safety.
3 This waiver of time applies only to Class D driving privileges.
4 Notwithstanding the foregoing, this section does not require the
5 Department of Public Safety to grant driving privileges to an
6 individual not otherwise eligible. Electronic notification of
7 graduation from an Oklahoma Drug Court Program shall be provided to
8 the Department of Public Safety by the court clerk in the county
9 where said program is situated. Such electronic notification shall
10 be consistent with the provisions of Section 18-101 of Title 47 of
11 the Oklahoma Statutes or by any other method approved by the
12 Department of Public Safety.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
