11 An Act relating to schools; creating the P-20 Council
12 Task Force; providing expiration date; setting duties
13 of certain task force; setting membership of certain
14 task force; providing for cochairs; setting quorum of
15 certain task force; providing date meetings may
16 begin; permitting certain meetings; subjecting
17 certain task force to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act;
18 prohibiting compensation and travel reimbursement;
19 requiring certain report; providing for
20 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
23 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

24 A. There is hereby created until November 1, 2011, the P-20
Council Task Force. The task force shall study the feasibility,

1 value and structure of a P-20 council or educational partnership
2 that would assure a seamless system of education that maximizes
3 achievements of all students from early childhood through
4 elementary, secondary, postsecondary and/or career technology
5 education.

6 B. The task force shall be composed of nine (9) members as
7 follows:

- 8 1. Secretary of Education or designee;
- 9 2. State Superintendent of Public Instruction or designee;
- 10 3. Chancellor of the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education
11 or designee;
- 12 4. State Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and
13 Technology Education or designee;
- 14 5. Chair of the Senate Education Committee;
- 15 6. Chair of the House of Representatives Common Education
16 Committee;
- 17 7. Chair of the House of Representatives Higher Education and
18 Career Tech Committee;
- 19 8. Chair of the Senate Education Appropriations subcommittee;
20 and
- 21 9. Chair of the House Education Appropriations and Budget
22 subcommittee.

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1 C. The Secretary of Education, the State Superintendent of
2 Public Instruction and the Chancellor of the Oklahoma State System
3 of Higher Education shall serve jointly as the cochairs of the task
4 force.

5 D. A quorum of the task force shall be required in order for
6 any final action of the task force. For purposes of this section
7 five members shall constitute a quorum.

8 E. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order
9 to perform the duties imposed upon it.

10 F. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the
11 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

12 G. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
13 travel reimbursement for their service.

14 H. The State Department of Education shall provide primary
15 staff support with the State Regents for Higher Education and
16 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education providing
17 assistance.

18 I. The task force shall report its findings, including any
19 legislative recommendations, to the President Pro Tempore of the
20 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
21 Governor by December 31, 2011.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
