

1 filing and shall not exceed one (1) year, unless otherwise provided
2 by law. The provisions of this section shall apply to all petitions
3 to be circulated in all or a portion of a county, if the provisions
4 thereof would require additional taxes or assessments, including but
5 not limited to, those authorized by the following provisions of law:

- 6 1. Section 782 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 7 2. Section 872 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 8 3. Section 901.2 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 9 4. Section 902.2 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 10 5. Section 1204 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
- 11 6. Section 1236 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 B. When any petition is to be circulated in all or a portion of
13 a county, each page of the petition shall contain a notice
14 prominently displayed at the top in at least twelve-point type which
15 reads "THIS IS A PETITION". The first page of the petition shall
16 contain a summary of the contents of the petition, which shall be
17 made available to any person who is or may be eligible to sign the
18 petition.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
