

- 1 3. Within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant, or if in an area
2 serviced by a volunteer fire department, within thirty (30) feet of
3 a fire hydrant if the governing body of the area so adopts by
4 ordinance;
- 5 4. Within an intersection;
- 6 5. On a crosswalk;
- 7 6. Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- 8 7. Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing
9 beacon, stop sign or traffic-control signal located at the side of a
10 roadway;
- 11 8. Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty
12 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety
13 zone, unless the authority having jurisdiction indicates a different
14 length by signs or marking;
- 15 9. Within fifty (50) feet of the nearest rail of a railroad
16 crossing;
- 17 10. Within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any
18 fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to
19 any fire station within seventy-five (75) feet of said entrance
20 (when properly signposted);
- 21 11. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction
22 when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
- 23 12. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the
24 edge or curb of a street;

1 13. Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway
2 or within a highway underpass;

3 14. At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.

4 B. No person engaging in the collection and disposal of solid
5 waste or recycling material or both as a business, pursuant to the
6 provisions of the Oklahoma Solid Waste Management Act, shall stop,
7 stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict
8 with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a
9 police officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following
10 places:

11 1. On a sidewalk;

12 2. Within an intersection;

13 3. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction
14 when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;

15 4. Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway
16 or within a highway underpass; or

17 5. At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.

18 C. No person shall move a vehicle not lawfully under the
19 control of the person into any prohibited area or away from a curb
20 such distance as is unlawful.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1004, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 11-1004. ~~(a)~~ A. Except as otherwise provided in this
24 section, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway where there

1 are adjacent curbs shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand
2 wheels of such vehicle parallel to and within eighteen (18) inches
3 of the right-hand curb.

4 ~~(b)~~ B. Local authorities may by ordinance permit parking of
5 vehicle with the left-hand wheels adjacent to and within eighteen
6 (18) inches of the left-hand curb of a one-way roadway.

7 ~~(c)~~ C. Local authorities may by ordinance permit angle parking
8 on any roadway, except that angle parking shall not be permitted on
9 any federal-aid or state highway unless the Department of Highways
10 has determined that the roadway is of sufficient width to permit
11 angle parking without interfering with the free movement of traffic.

12 ~~(d)~~ D. The Oklahoma Department of Highways with respect to
13 highways under its jurisdiction may place signs prohibiting or
14 restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any
15 highway where such stopping, standing or parking is dangerous to
16 those using the highway or where the stopping, standing or parking
17 of vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic
18 thereon. Such signs shall be official signs and no person shall
19 stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions
20 stated on such signs.

21 E. A person engaging in the collection and disposal of solid
22 waste or recycling material or both as a business, pursuant to the
23 provisions of the Oklahoma Solid Waste Management Act, shall be

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1 exempt from the provisions of subsections A and B of this section
2 while in the performance of such activities.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
