



1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
2 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
4 Bicycle Safety Awareness Act".

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-124 of Title 47, unless there  
7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 A. An applicant for an original or replacement driver license  
9 or identification card shall be given an opportunity to make a  
10 voluntary contribution of One Dollar (\$1.00) or more to be credited  
11 to the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund established  
12 in Section 3 of this act. Any voluntary contribution shall be added  
13 to the driver license or identification card fee or fees as provided  
14 by law and then be referred to the State Treasurer and credited to  
15 the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund as provided in  
16 Section 3 of this act.

17 B. The Department of Public Safety or motor license agents  
18 shall inquire of each applicant, at the time of presentation of a  
19 completed application for an original or renewal driver license or  
20 identification card, whether the applicant is interested in making  
21 the One Dollar (\$1.00) or more contribution prescribed in subsection  
22 A of this section.

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1 C. The incremental cost of administration of contributions to  
2 the fund, not to exceed one percent (1%) of the monies received  
3 pursuant to the provisions of this section, shall be paid by the  
4 fund to the Department of Public Safety from amounts received  
5 pursuant to the provisions of this section before funds are expended  
6 for the purposes of the fund.

7 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there  
9 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
11 fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the  
12 "Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
13 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and  
14 shall consist of all monies received by the Department of Public  
15 Safety from:

16 1. Any state monies appropriated for the purpose of  
17 implementing the provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness  
18 Act; and

19 2. Any monies collected pursuant to this section or any other  
20 monies available to the Department of Public Safety to implement the  
21 provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Act.

22 B. All monies credited to the fund are hereby appropriated and  
23 shall be budgeted and expended to provide awareness to the road

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1 traveling public of the presence of bicyclists by any media  
2 promotions, publications or signage.

3 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
