

1 B. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter and subject to
2 exceptions for parked vehicles, every vehicle upon a highway within
3 this state shall properly display all lamps and illuminating devices
4 as required by law:

5 1. At any time from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset to one-
6 half (1/2) hour before sunrise, also referred to in this chapter as
7 nighttime; and

8 2. At any other time when, due to insufficient light or
9 unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the
10 highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand
11 (1,000) feet or less.

12 C. Any vehicle used for the purpose of public transportation,
13 including buses, vans, trolley cars and similar vehicles, shall be
14 required to utilize headlamps, tail lamps and other appropriate
15 lighting equipment at all times, subject to exception for parked
16 vehicles.

17 D. All lamps required by this chapter shall display a steady
18 light except as otherwise prescribed by this chapter. Any required
19 individual lamp may be combined or incorporated with any other
20 required individual lamp if the combined or incorporated lamps meet
21 all of the individual lighting requirements of this chapter for each
22 individual lamp contained therein.
