11 An Act relating to professional licenses; creating a
12 task force; stating purpose; providing for
13 appointment of membership, term, quorum and vacancy;
14 prohibiting travel reimbursement; designating chair;
15 providing for vice-chair; requiring certain report by
16 certain date; and providing for noncodification.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 A. A task force is hereby created to review and evaluate the
21 potential for consolidation of licensing functions for professional
22 and trade occupations in this state. The task force shall further
23 review and evaluate the potential costs and benefits of transferring

1 the authority, powers and duties of the various boards and
2 commissions that provide oversight and regulation of professions and
3 trades considered for review by the task force.

4 B. The task force shall consist of nine (9) members. Four
5 members shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
6 Senate. Four members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House
7 of Representatives. One member shall be appointed by the Governor.
8 Each member shall serve a term until January 1, 2012. A quorum
9 shall be five (5) members and each member shall have one vote.
10 Members shall not receive travel reimbursement. Any vacancy in
11 membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing
12 authority.

13 C. The task force shall be chaired by the Governor's appointee
14 and a vice-chair may be selected by the majority of the appointed
15 members. The task force shall report its findings to the President
16 Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
17 Representatives, and the Governor not later than January 1, 2012.
