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9 A Concurrent Resolution approving the transfer of
10 certain personal property and real property under the
11 jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
12 Commission to certain governmental entity; specifying
13 that certain rights shall be retained; making certain
14 transfer null and void in specified circumstance;
15 making the transfer subject to certain authority and
16 requirements; and providing for distribution.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA
18 LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

19 THAT, pursuant to Section 2224 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes, the Oklahoma Legislature hereby approves the transfer of
21 personal property and real property containing approximately 588.5
22 acres at the area known as Boggy Depot State Park owned by the
23 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and operated and
24 maintained under the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Tourism and
25 Recreation Commission to the Chickasaw Nation, an agency of

1 government and an eligible sponsor for land and water conservation
2 funds under the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund program.

3 THAT, of the property transferred, all water and mineral rights
4 shall be retained by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
5 and/or the State of Oklahoma.

6 THAT, if the real property currently known as Boggy Depot State
7 Park ever ceases to be used for public recreational facilities, this
8 transfer shall be null and void and the real property shall revert
9 to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and/or the State
10 of Oklahoma.

11 THAT, the Chickasaw Nation shall not place the property in trust
12 for the Chickasaw Nation or any other sovereign nation and any
13 action by the Chickasaw Nation to do so shall cause the property to
14 automatically revert to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
15 Department and/or the State of Oklahoma.

16 THAT, the real estate and personal property transfer shall be
17 subject to the authority and requirements in Section 2224 of Title
18 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

19 THAT, copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,
20 the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the Oklahoma Tourism
21 and Recreation Commission and the Executive Director of the Oklahoma
22 Tourism and Recreation Department.
