12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28 of Title 21, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any United States Attorney or Assistant United States
17 Attorney may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the
18 State of Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an
19 approved course of firearm training conducted by a certified
20 firearms instructor which is equal to the minimum requirements for
21 firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement
22 Education and Training.

23 B. Any current member of the Oklahoma State Legislature may
24 carry a firearm on his or her person any where in the State of

1 Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an approved course
2 of firearm training conducted by a certified firearms instructor
3 which is equal to the minimum requirements for firearms training as
4 set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
