13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 61.7 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby established the Oklahoma State Government
18 Asset Reduction and Cost Savings Program.

19 B. No later than December 31 each year the Director of Central
20 Services shall publish a comprehensive report detailing state-owned
21 properties.

22 C. The report mandated in accordance with the provisions of
23 this section shall list the five percent (5%) most underutilized
24 state-owned properties. The report shall describe the value of

1 properties falling within the description in this subsection, assess
2 the potential for purchase should the properties be offered for sale
3 and describe the impact on local-level tax rolls in the event the
4 properties are purchased by a nongovernmental entity.

5 D. The Director of Central Services shall promulgate rules
6 establishing procedures by which each state agency, board,
7 commission and public trust having the State of Oklahoma as a
8 beneficiary shall submit the necessary data to the Department of
9 Central Services for the development of this report.

10 E. State agencies, boards, commissions and public trusts having
11 the State of Oklahoma as a beneficiary shall comply with procedures
12 promulgated pursuant to the terms of this section.

13 F. The report and data collected pursuant to this section shall
14 be published as a data feed on the "data.ok.gov" website.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
