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10 An Act relating to public health and safety;  
11 providing that certain pharmacist shall be required  
12 to visit certain center no more than once per month;  
13 requiring test for human immunodeficiency virus in  
14 certain circumstances; defining term; providing for  
15 codification; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2663A of Title 63, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A consultant pharmacist shall be required to visit an ambulatory  
21 surgical center no more than one time per month.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-515.1 of Title 63, unless  
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       A. Every physician or any other person permitted by law to  
2 attend upon pregnant females in this state, at the time of delivery  
3 and only if the pregnant female has had no prenatal care, shall:

4           1. Take, or cause to be taken under the order of a physician  
5 licensed to practice in this state, a sample of blood from the  
6 pregnant female; and

7           2. Submit the sample to an approved laboratory for a standard  
8 serological test for the human immunodeficiency virus.

9       B. The term "approved laboratory" shall mean a laboratory  
10 approved for the purposes of this section by the State Commissioner  
11 of Health. A standard serological test for the human  
12 immunodeficiency virus shall be one recognized as such by the  
13 Commissioner. Such laboratory tests shall be made, on request,  
14 without charge by the State Department of Health.

15       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
