8 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,  
9 Section 13-102, which relates to municipal elections;  
10 modifying information contained in certain  
11 resolution; providing an effective date; and  
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 13-102, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 13-102. A. Not fewer than fifteen (15) days before the  
17 filing period for any regular municipal election, or in the event of  
18 a special election, not fewer than sixty (60) days before such  
19 election, the governing board of any municipality shall submit a  
20 resolution to the secretary of the county election board conducting  
21 such election. Such resolution shall contain the following ~~facts~~:

- 22 1. The dates of the election or elections;  
23 2. The offices to be filled or the questions to be voted upon  
24 at such election or elections;

1 3. Qualifications for such offices;

2 4. Designation of which offices shall be filled by voting by  
3 ward and which offices shall be filled by voting at large;

4 5. Indication of whether the election will be partisan or  
5 nonpartisan;

6 6. For charter cities where the charter is silent, indication  
7 of any portion of state law which will apply; ~~and~~

8 7. A list of precincts partially contained within the limits of  
9 the municipality which are eligible to be closed pursuant to the  
10 provisions of subsection C of Section 13-103 of this title, and a  
11 certification of whether such precincts shall be open or not open  
12 for the election; and

13 8. Any other information necessary for conducting said election  
14 or elections.

15 B. In the event that a municipality governed by charter  
16 schedules a regular or special election for a municipal office on  
17 the same date as an election involving state or federal offices, the  
18 filing period for such municipal office shall be scheduled on a  
19 Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday not less than fifteen (15) days nor  
20 more than twenty (20) days following the date of the resolution or  
21 order.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
