12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-415 of Title 29, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A person or business operating as a meat processor in this state
17 may release any unclaimed, processed, lawfully harvested venison to
18 the Department of Wildlife Conservation's Hunters Against Hunger
19 Program after a period of ninety (90) days following notification by
20 telephone to the person who brought the wild game for processing
21 that the wild game has been processed and is available for
22 collection. The meat processor shall receive the normal
23 reimbursement fee from Hunters Against Hunger.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
