10 **[intoxicating liquors - low-point beer -
11 codification - effective date]**

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.7a of Title 37, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Every retail dealer permit issued by the Oklahoma Tax
17 Commission pursuant to paragraph 3 of Section 163.7 of Title 37 of
18 the Oklahoma Statutes shall have printed on its face whether it is
19 for consumption on premises, consumption off premises or both.

20 B. Every person who sells low-point beer at retail shall
21 post conspicuously and keep so posted at the place of business the
22 license required pursuant to paragraph 3 of Section 163.7 of Title
23 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 C. When a person violates subsection B of this section, the
2 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission shall impose
3 an administrative fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
4 each day a violation occurs. Each day a violation is continuing
5 shall constitute a separate offense.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
