9 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
10 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 220, which relates to
11 the Court Clerk's Revolving Fund; transferring duties
12 from State Auditor and Inspector to Administrative
13 Director of the Courts; and providing an effective
14 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 220, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 220. A. Beginning July 1, 1991, there is hereby
18 created with the county treasurer of each county within this state a
19 depository revolving fund to be designated the "Court Clerk's
20 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
21 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
22 as grants from the federal government and any other monies
23 designated by law for deposit into the fund. All monies accruing to
24 the credit of the fund ~~are hereby appropriated and~~ shall be expended

1 by the court clerk for the lawful operation of the court clerk's
2 office. Claims against the fund shall include only expenses
3 incurred for the operation of the court clerk's office in each
4 county, and payment may be made after the claim is approved by the
5 court clerk and either the district or the associate district judge
6 of that county. The monies shall be reported quarterly to the
7 Administrator of the Courts. The necessary forms and procedures
8 shall be developed and implemented by the ~~State Auditor and~~
9 ~~Inspector~~ Administrative Director of the Courts.

10 B. There shall be no monies, other than federal funds,
11 deposited into the fund created herein, unless expressly authorized
12 by the Legislature.

13 C. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the court clerk
14 shall assess an administrative fee of ten percent (10%) on all fees
15 collected by the court clerk for agencies other than the court and
16 not deposited into the court fund. The administrative fee shall not
17 attach to the sheriff's service fees provided for in Sections 153
18 and 153.2 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes, monies deposited
19 into the Law Library Fund, witness fees paid by the district
20 attorney pursuant to the provisions of Section 82 of Title 28 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes, and dispute resolution fees provided for in
22 Section 1809 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
23 administrative fees shall be deposited in the Court Clerk's
24 Revolving Fund.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
