13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State
18 Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 64 extending east to the junction of
19 State Highway 11 and State Highway 38 shall be designated as the
20 "U.S. Border Patrol Chief Donald R. Coppock Memorial Highway".

21 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
22 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
23 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of State Highway 58 from the junction of State
5 Highway 58 and State Highway 45 extending north to the junction of
6 State Highway 58 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the
7 "Coach Ray Troutt Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
8 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
9 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
10 bearing that name.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State
15 Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 77 extending east to Kaw City, Oklahoma,
16 shall be designated as the "Senator David Myers Memorial Highway".
17 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
18 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
19 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge crossing Grand Lake on U.S. Highway 59 in Delaware
24 County between Copeland, Oklahoma, and Grove, Oklahoma, shall be

1 designated as the "Veldo M. Goins Memorial Bridge". The Department
2 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
3 placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 from the junction of U.S. Highway
8 75 and U.S. Highway 412 extending south to the junction of U.S.
9 Highway 75 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Paul
10 Harvey Memorial Expressway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69
11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall
12 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
13 bearing that name.

14 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The portion of U.S. Highway 70 from Broken Bow, Oklahoma,
18 extending south to Idabel, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
19 "Representative Rusty Farley Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the
20 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
21 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
22 upon the highway bearing that name.

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1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge crossing State Highway 50 north of Freedom, Oklahoma,
5 near the intersection of State Highway 50 and U.S. Highway 64 shall
6 be designated as the "Wesley and Maxine Nixon Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

9 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.119 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The portion of State Highway 125 from the junction of State
13 Highway 125 and State Highway 85A extending south to where State
14 Highway 125 terminates on Monkey Island shall be designated as the
15 "Charles Davis Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
16 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
18 bearing that name.

19 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.120 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of Interstate 35 from the junction of Interstate 35
23 and Indian Hills Road extending south to junction of Interstate 35
24 and State Highway 9 West shall be designated as the "Dr. James E.

1 and Representative Mina M. Hibdon Memorial Highway". Pursuant to
2 the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department
3 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
4 placed upon the highway bearing that name.

5 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.121 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The portion of Interstate 44 from the point one (1) mile north
9 of the intersection of Interstate 44 and U.S. Highway 62 extending
10 south to the intersection of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 shall
11 be designated as the "Bill W. Burgess Jr. Highway". Pursuant to the
12 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
14 upon the highway bearing that name.

15 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.122 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The portion of State Highway 48 in Creek County from the
19 junction of State Highway 48 and West 251st Street South extending
20 south to the junction of State Highway 48 and East 950 Road shall be
21 designated as the "Major Brice Clayton Coleman Memorial Highway".
22 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.123 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of United States Highway 81 located within the
5 municipal limits of the City of Hennessey shall be designated as
6 "Senator Ralph J. Choate Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the
7 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
9 on the highway bearing that name.

10 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.124 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the junction of U.S.
14 Highway 75 and West 201st Street South extending south to Okmulgee,
15 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Trooper William McClendon
16 Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
19 that name.

20 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.125 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The portion of State Highway 34 from the Dewey County and Custer
24 County line extending northward to the Canadian River shall be

1 designated as "Jimmy Harrel Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
2 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
3 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
4 bearing that name.

5 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.126 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The portion of State Highway 39 extending from the municipal
9 limits of the city of Asher to the municipal limits of the city of
10 Konawa shall be designated as the "Deputy Mike Roberts and Deputy
11 Tim Lowry Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69
12 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall
13 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway

14 SECTION 16. It being immediately necessary for the
15 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
16 hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
18 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
