9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
10 Investigation; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1,
11 which relates to the Internet Crimes Against Children
12 unit; authorizing the Director of the Bureau to enter
13 into certain cooperative agreements for the purpose
14 of appointing certain agents to assist the unit;
15 making such agents employees and commissioned law
16 enforcement officers of certain law enforcement
17 agencies; providing for certain powers of the agents;
18 providing for renewal, suspension or revocation of
19 the agreements; providing that agents serve at the
20 discretion and will of the Director of the Bureau;
21 and providing an effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1, is
24 amended to read as follows:

25 Section 151.1. A. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
26 (OSBI) shall establish an Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC)
27 unit for the primary purpose of investigating Internet crimes
28 committed against children, including, but not limited to, offenses

1 related to child pornography and solicitation of minors for
2 pornography, prostitution or sex-related offenses. The unit shall
3 additionally promote safe Internet use among children and their
4 parents by various media or printed-material campaigns or by
5 offering educational programs to schools or communities throughout
6 this state. The Bureau shall employ sufficient employees to
7 investigate and implement the ICAC unit.

8 B. The Director of the OSBI is hereby authorized to enter into
9 local cooperative agreements with local law enforcement agencies for
10 the purpose of appointing ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents to assist
11 the ICAC unit of the OSBI. ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents shall
12 be employees and commissioned law enforcement officers of the local
13 law enforcement agency entering into agreement with the Oklahoma
14 State Bureau of Investigation and shall not be employees of the
15 OSBI. ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents shall have general peace
16 officer powers throughout the state, including the authority to
17 arrest, for the purpose of investigating Internet crimes committed
18 against children, including, but not limited to, offenses related to
19 child pornography and solicitation of minors for pornography,
20 prostitution or sex-related offenses and to promote safe Internet
21 use among children and their parents by various media or printed-
22 material campaigns or by offering educational programs to schools or
23 communities throughout Oklahoma. The Director of the OSBI may
24 renew, suspend or revoke any agreement appointing an ICAC Affiliate

1 Task Force Agent at any time. Individuals serve as ICAC Affiliate
2 Task Force Agents solely at the discretion and will of the OSBI
3 Director.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
