10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1370.2 of Title 59, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The chair of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists, upon
15 concurrence of the vice chair of the Board that an emergency exists
16 for which the immediate suspension of a license is imperative for
17 the public health, safety, and welfare, may conduct a hearing as
18 provided by Section 314 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes to
19 temporarily suspend the license of any person under the jurisdiction
20 of the Board.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
