8 [Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act - revolving fund
9 - maintenance revolving fund - making funds
10 inoperable upon certain event -
11 emergency]

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 254, O.S.L.
14 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 9030.6), is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Section 9030.6 A. 1. There is hereby created in the State
17 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be
18 designated the "Commissioning of Art in Public Places Revolving
19 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
20 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
21 Society from the sources provided for in Section ~~6~~ 9030.5 of this
22 act title.

23 2. The Society shall establish a separate subaccount for each
24 project. Monies in these subaccounts may be used to match monies

1 from other private and public sources for commissioning art in
2 accordance with the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act.

3 3. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
5 Historical Society for the commissioning of art and insurance for
6 the art in accordance with the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act.

7 4. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
8 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
9 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

10 B. If there are monies from a project for the commissioning of
11 art not spent, those monies may be pooled in the fund for the
12 commissioning of art in, on, or near other state buildings.

13 C. The fund shall cease to exist upon the expenditure of any
14 monies that accrued to the fund prior to the effective date of this
15 act.

16 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 8, Chapter 254, O.S.L.
17 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 9030.7), is amended to read as
18 follows:

19 Section 9030.7 A. 1. There is hereby created in the State
20 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be
21 designated the "Art in Public Places Administrative and Maintenance
22 Revolving Fund". All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are
23 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Society.
24 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year

1 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Society
2 from the sources provided for in Section ~~6~~ 9030.5 of this ~~act~~ title.

3 2. This fund shall consist of two subaccounts, one account for
4 maintenance and repair purposes and one account for administrative
5 and education purposes. Monies accruing to the credit of the
6 subaccount for maintenance and repair shall be used for the purpose
7 of restoring art in all state public buildings including, but not
8 limited to, public buildings at institutions within The Oklahoma
9 State System of Higher Education.

10 3. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
11 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
12 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

13 B. Whenever the unencumbered balance in this fund exceeds One
14 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), the assessment shall be placed in
15 the Commissioning of Art in Public Places Revolving Fund to the
16 credit of the subaccount established for the project upon which the
17 assessment was made.

18 C. The fund shall cease to exist upon the expenditure of any
19 monies that accrued to the fund prior to the effective date of this
20 act.

21 SECTION 3. REPEALER Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Chapter
22 254, O.S.L. 2004 and Section 6, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 2004, as amended
23 by Section 2, Chapter 400, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Sections
24

1 9030, 9030.1, 9030.2, 9030.3, 9030.4 and 9030.5), are hereby
2 repealed.

3 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
