8 **[motor vehicles - oversize vehicle permits -
9 codification - effective date]**

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-130 of Title 47, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Upon the effective date of this act and in addition to the other
16 permitting procedures authorized pursuant to this chapter, the
17 Commissioner of Public Safety is directed to issue oversize permits
18 according to the following:

19 1. A ninety (90) day permit for oversized loads on state-
20 maintained roads that are no greater than thirteen (13) feet wide
21 and fourteen (14) feet high or the legal length for an overwidth
22 permit no greater than eight and one-half (8 1/2) feet wide,
23 fourteen (14) feet high, and one hundred and ten (110) feet long.
24 For vehicles and loads on a trailer for an overlength permit, the

1 size shall be no longer than seventy-five (75) feet for single
2 vehicles moving empty or hauling a load. Portable buildings and
3 manufactured homes shall not be authorized to obtain a permit
4 pursuant to this section.

5 The permit expires ninety (90) days from the date specified on
6 the application of when movement begins. The vehicle shall be
7 properly registered with this state according to law; the vehicle
8 tag number shall accompany the application, and a permit issued
9 shall be assigned to that vehicle tag number only. A permit shall
10 not be issued to a vehicle with temporary registration.

11 The fee for a ninety (90) day permit shall be Two Hundred Forty
12 Dollars (\$240.00). The permittee shall be responsible for obtaining
13 routing and any current restrictions on eligible roads. The
14 permittee shall not travel over load-posted bridges that exceed
15 capacity. Travel shall be for daylight hours only unless the load
16 does not exceed ten (10) feet wide or one hundred (100) feet long
17 with legal front and rear overhang; then the vehicle may travel at
18 night on the interstate system only. Permits may not be amended or
19 transferred between vehicles or permittees.

20 2. A one-day prepaid permit for oversized loads on pre-approved
21 routes as obtained by the applicant through the proper routing
22 requirements. The permit shall be assigned to a route and the
23 applicant shall include the vehicle tag number and a trailer tag
24 number, if applicable, to be assigned to the permit. The permittee

1 may activate the one-day permit online. Such permits shall only be
2 valid for one (1) year from the date the prepaid permit was
3 authorized by the Department of Public Safety. The fee for a one-
4 day prepaid permit shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

5 The Department is authorized to promulgate any rules necessary
6 for the implementation of this act.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
