12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any person who, **without good cause**, maliciously and knowingly
17 cuts or damages a fence used for the production or containment of
18 cattle, bison, horses, sheep, swine, goats, domestic fowl, exotic
19 livestock, exotic poultry, exotic livestock or any game animals or
20 domesticated game such that there is a loss or damage to such
21 property is guilty of a felony.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
