8 An Act relating to mental health and substance abuse;  
9 amending 43A O.S. 2011, Sections 3-101 and 3-323A,  
10 which relate to mental health and substance abuse  
11 facilities; deleting requirement for maintenance of  
12 certain facilities; modifying name of certain  
13 certification; exempting certain facilities from  
14 specified requirement; repealing 43A O.S. 2011,  
15 Section 3-106, which relates to community mental  
16 health facilities; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-101, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 3-101. The facilities within the Department of Mental  
21 Health and Substance Abuse Services, which may be maintained for  
22 residents of the state, are:

- 23 1. Griffin Memorial Hospital, Norman;
- 24 2. Oklahoma Forensic Center, Vinita;
3. Children's Recovery Center of Oklahoma, Norman;
4. Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health, Tulsa;

- 1 5. Carl Albert Community Mental Health Center, McAlester;
- 2 6. Jim Taliaferro Community Mental Health Center, Lawton;
- 3 7. Central Oklahoma Community Mental Health Center, Norman;
- 4 8. ~~Bill Willis Community Mental Health and Substance Abuse~~
- 5 ~~Services Center, Tahlequah;~~
- 6 ~~9.~~ Northwest Center for Behavioral Health, Woodward;
- 7 ~~10.~~ 9. Oklahoma County Crisis Intervention Center, Oklahoma
- 8 City;
- 9 ~~11.~~ ~~Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment Center, Norman;~~ and
- 10 ~~12.~~ 10. Rose Rock Recovery Center, Vinita.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-323A, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 3-323A. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance  
14 Abuse Services shall promulgate rules and standards for  
15 certification of a facility or organization that desires to be  
16 certified as a ~~"Mental Illness Service Program"~~ an "Outpatient  
17 Mental Health Treatment Organization".

18 B. Applications for certification as a ~~mental illness service~~  
19 ~~program~~ an outpatient mental health treatment organization shall be  
20 made to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
21 on prescribed forms. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental  
22 Health and Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board,  
23 may certify mental illness service programs for a period of three  
24

1 (3) years, subject to renewal as provided in the rules promulgated  
2 by the Board.

3 C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
4 is authorized to establish and collect certification and renewal  
5 fees for certification of ~~mental illness service programs~~ outpatient  
6 mental health treatment organizations as provided in Section 3-324  
7 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 D. ~~A certified mental illness service program~~ An outpatient  
9 mental health treatment organization shall comply with standards  
10 adopted by the Board. Such standards shall be in compliance with:

11 1. The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare  
12 Organizations;

13 2. The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation  
14 Facilities; or

15 3. Approved medical and professional standards as determined by  
16 the Board.

17 E. Hospitals licensed by the State Department of Health shall  
18 be exempt from certification requirements as an outpatient mental  
19 health treatment organization.

20 F. Failure to comply with rules and standards promulgated by  
21 the Board shall be grounds for revocation, suspension or nonrenewal  
22 of certification.

23 SECTION 3. REPEALER 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-106, is  
24 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
