13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
17 Bicycle Safety Awareness Act".

18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-124 of Title 47, unless there  
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. An applicant for an original or replacement driver license  
22 or identification card shall be given an opportunity to make a  
23 voluntary contribution of One Dollar (\$1.00) or more to be credited  
24 to the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund established

1 in Section 3 of this act. Any voluntary contribution shall be added  
2 to the driver license or identification card fee or fees as provided  
3 by law and then be referred to the State Treasurer and credited to  
4 the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund as provided in  
5 Section 3 of this act.

6 B. The Department of Public Safety or motor license agents  
7 shall inquire of each applicant, at the time of presentation of a  
8 completed application for an original or renewal driver license or  
9 identification card, whether the applicant is interested in making  
10 the One Dollar (\$1.00) or more contribution prescribed in subsection  
11 A of this section.

12 C. The incremental cost of administration of contributions to  
13 the fund, not to exceed one percent (1%) of the monies received  
14 pursuant to the provisions of this section, shall be paid by the  
15 fund to the Department of Public Safety from amounts received  
16 pursuant to the provisions of this section before funds are expended  
17 for the purposes of the fund.

18 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there  
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
22 fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the  
23 "Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
24 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and

1 shall consist of all monies received by the Department of Public  
2 Safety from:

3 1. Any state monies appropriated for the purpose of  
4 implementing the provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness  
5 Act; and

6 2. Any monies collected pursuant to this section or any other  
7 monies available to the Department of Public Safety to implement the  
8 provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Act.

9 B. All monies credited to the fund are hereby appropriated and  
10 shall be budgeted and expended to provide awareness to the road  
11 traveling public of the presence of bicyclists by any media  
12 promotions, publications or signage.

13 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
