11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2001, Section 30.11, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 30.11. Judges of the Court of Civil Appeals shall be
15 elected or appointed from the Congressional Districts with the
16 boundaries as they exist at the time the Judge is elected or
17 appointed to office; however, should the boundaries of the six
18 Congressional Districts be revised and elections for the office of
19 United States Representative be conducted using the revised
20 boundaries, then the revised boundaries shall also be used in the
21 conduct of any elections required for the office of Judge of the
22 Court of Civil Appeals; except that Judges of the Court of Civil
23 Appeals seeking retention shall be retained in the original
24 Congressional District from which they were elected or appointed;

1 provided, however, nothing in this section shall be construed to
2 require a change of residence of a Judge of the Court of Civil
3 Appeals seeking retention. Should the number of Congressional
4 Districts be increased or decreased, the sections of law which
5 define the area of each of the six Congressional Districts shall
6 remain in effect for the purpose of this act, and at that time the
7 sections shall be renumbered and codified in this title of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes following this act.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
