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8 An Act relating to motor vehicle registration
9 information; stating purpose; authorizing the
10 Commissioner of Public Safety to direct development
of certain cooperative agreement; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.3 of Title 47, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. In an effort to improve the public safety of all citizens of
18 this state, a more uniform and expeditious method of obtaining
19 ownership and registration information of all motor vehicles
20 operating on the roads and highways of this state is required. Any
21 method developed shall be conducted in accordance with subsection B
22 of this section.

23 B. In addition to the powers and duties prescribed by law, the
24 Commissioner of Public Safety shall be authorized to direct the

1 Department of Public Safety to develop a proposal for an
2 intergovernmental cooperative agreement pursuant to paragraph 1 of
3 subsection D of Section 1221 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes
4 between the Department and all tribal governments that issue tribal
5 license plates and maintain ownership and registration information.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
