8 A Joint Resolution approving permanent rules relating
9 to the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality;
10 directing distribution; and declaring an emergency.

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma
13 Statutes, any rule which establishes or increases fees shall require
14 approval by the Legislature by joint resolution. If the Legislature
15 fails to approve the rule on or before the last day of the
16 legislative session, the rule shall be deemed disapproved; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 2-2-101, 2-3-
18 402, 2-6-103, 2-6-203, 2-6-402 and 2-6-501 of Title 27A of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes, the Environmental Quality Board shall adopt the
20 rules for the implementation of the provisions of the Environmental
21 Quality Code; and

22 WHEREAS, the permanent rules at OAC 252:627 and OAC 252:656
23 adopted by the Board on February 24, 2012, reflect the intent of the
24 Oklahoma Legislature.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby approves the permanent rules
4 at OAC 252:627 and OAC 252:656, which were adopted by the
5 Environmental Quality Board on February 24, 2012.

6 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
7 distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Department
8 of Environmental Quality, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
12 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
