7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 540D of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who willfully delays or obstructs a law enforcement
16 officer or emergency personnel in the performance of official duties
17 by using any animal, fowl, reptile or insect, wild or tame, to
18 interfere, restrict or prevent access by a law enforcement officer
19 or emergency personnel to any dwelling, structure, building or
20 vehicle where a criminal offense is being committed or attempted
21 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by
22 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a
23 term of not more than five (5) years, or by a fine in an amount not

1 exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine
2 and imprisonment.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
