8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma House of
10 Representatives; making an appropriation; stating
11 purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; requiring
12 certain approval for claims and payrolls; and
13 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House
17 of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
18 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2012, the following amount, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary to pay monthly salaries, per diem, and expenses of
21 the members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the
22 salaries of its employees, and such contingent expenses as may be
23 ordered paid therefrom, including the preparation and printing of
24 the journals and calendars of the Oklahoma House of Representatives,

1 and including the preparation and printing of the permanent journals
2 thereof, in accordance with the following amount herein set forth:

3 For expenses of personal services (including
4 retirement and insurance costs), including those
5 of members, and employees of the Oklahoma House
6 of Representatives, and expenses of maintenance
7 and operation, including travel expenses,
8 supplies, materials, printing, equipment, and
9 printing of permanent journals, session laws, and
10 supplements; and for the renovation and
11 modification of the Oklahoma House of
12 Representatives area; and other necessary
13 expenses \$_____ .00

14 Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made to the
15 Oklahoma House of Representatives for the fiscal year ending June
16 30, 2012, shall be approved by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
17 Representatives.

18 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
19 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
20 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
21 months from the date this act is approved.

22 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 2011.
