9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;  
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of Executive Director and Deputy  
Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations;  
15 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting  
16 certain budget procedures; providing lapse dates; and  
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
20 Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
22 ending June 30, 2012, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
23 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
24 Oklahoma Historical Society by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the  
2 Oklahoma Historical Society shall budget all funds in the following  
3 categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
13 upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the  
14 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary  
15 of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall  
16 not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum and the salary of the  
17 Deputy Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall  
18 not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012. The Oklahoma Historical  
20 Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, shall be subject  
21 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent  
22 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and  
23 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
24 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

4 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
 5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
 6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12) or may be  
 7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 (hereafter FY-13).  
 8 Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
 9 2012, and must be expended by November 15, 2012. Any funds  
 10 remaining after November 15, 2012, and not budgeted for FY-13, shall  
 11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
 12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-13 may be encumbered only through June  
 13 30, 2013. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2013, shall lapse  
 14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
 15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
 16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-12, and not required to pay  
 17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-13, after  
 18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
 19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
 20 from the FY-12 budget work program and after such revision has been  
 21 approved by the Office of State Finance.

22 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 2011.
