9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and  
11 Recreation Department; making an appropriation;  
12 stating purpose; providing for duties and  
13 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the  
14 Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring  
15 certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget  
16 procedures; providing lapse dates; and providing an  
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism  
20 and Recreation Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
21 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
22 year ending June 30, 2012, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so  
23 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon  
24 the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the  
 2 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department shall budget all funds in  
 3 the following categories and amounts:

23 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law shall be  
2 set by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. The salary  
3 of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
4 annum payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012. The  
5 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for the fiscal year  
6 ending June 30, 2012, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
7 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
8 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
9 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
10 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

16 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12) or may be  
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 (hereafter FY-13).  
20 Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
21 2012, and must be expended by November 15, 2012. Any funds  
22 remaining after November 15, 2012, and not budgeted for FY-13, shall  
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-13 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2013. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2013, shall lapse  
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-12, and not required to pay  
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-13, after  
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
8 from the FY-12 budget work program and after such revision has been  
9 approved by the Office of State Finance.

10 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 2011.

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
