9	to payments for certain health care costs; modifying amounts payable to retirees; providing an effective
10	date; and declaring an emergency.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 1316.3, as
15	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 198, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp.
16	2010, Section 1316.3), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1316.3 A. Any person who retires pursuant to the
18	provisions of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma with at
19	least ten (10) years of creditable service or who has a vested
20	benefit with at least ten (10) years of creditable service, pursuant
21	to the provisions of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma may
22	continue in force the health and dental insurance benefits
23	authorized by the provisions of the State and Education Employees
24	Group Insurance Act if such election to continue in force or begin

is made within thirty (30) days from the date of termination of 1 Except as provided in subsection E of Sections 5-117.5 and 2 service. 14-108.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Section 840-2.27I 3 of this title and subsection K of this section, health and dental 4 5 insurance coverage may not be reinstated at a later time if the election to continue in force or begin coverage is declined. Vested 6 persons who have terminated service and are not receiving benefits 7 and effective July 1, 1996, nonvested persons who have terminated 8 9 service with more than ten (10) years of participating service with 10 a qualifying employer, who within thirty (30) days from the date of termination of service, elect to continue such coverage, shall pay 11 12 the full cost of said insurance premium at the rate and pursuant to 13 the terms and conditions established by the Board.

B. 1. Health insurance benefit plans offered pursuant to thissection shall include:

- a. indemnity plans offered through the State and
 Education Employees Group Insurance Board,
 b. managed game plang offered as alternatives to
- b. managed care plans offered as alternatives to the
 indemnity plans,
- 20 c. Medicare supplements offered through the State and
 21 Education Employees Group Insurance Board,
 - d. Medicare risk-sharing contracts offered as alternatives to the Medicare supplements offered
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- through the State and Education Employees Group
 Insurance Board, and
- e. any other employer-provided health insurance benefit
 plans if the employer does not participate in the
 plans offered pursuant to the State and Education
 Employees Group Insurance Act.

7 2. Health insurance benefit plans offered pursuant to this
8 section shall provide prescription drug benefits, except for plans
9 designed pursuant to the Medicare Prescription Drug Improvement and
10 Modernization Act of 2003, which may or may not contain prescription
11 drug benefits, for which provision of prescription drug benefits is
12 optional, and except for plans offered pursuant to subparagraph e of
13 paragraph 1 of this subsection.

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C. A retired person who:

Is receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System
 of Oklahoma after September 30, 1988, is under sixty-five (65) years
 of age and is not otherwise eligible for Medicare and pursuant to
 subsection A of this section elects to begin or to continue the
 health insurance plan;

Is receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System 21 of Oklahoma after June 30, 1993, is under sixty-five (65) years of 22 age and is not otherwise eligible for Medicare and participates in a 23 health insurance plan provided by a participating education employer 24 of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma other than a health

insurance plan offered pursuant to the State and Education Employees
 Group Insurance Act or an alternative health plan offered pursuant
 to the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Act;

3. Is receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System
of Oklahoma after September 30, 1988, made contributions to the
system and is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, or who is under
sixty-five (65) years of age and is eligible for Medicare and is a
participant in the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act
and elects coverage under the Medicare supplement offered by the
State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; or

Is receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System 11 4. of Oklahoma after June 30, 1993, made contributions to the system 12 and is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, or who is under sixty-13 five (65) years of age and is eligible for Medicare and participates 14 in a health insurance plan provided by a participating education 15 employer of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma other than a 16 health insurance plan offered pursuant to the State and Education 17 Employees Group Insurance Act or an alternative health plan offered 18 pursuant to the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Act and elects 19 coverage under the Medicare supplement offered by the State and 20 Education Employees Group Insurance Board, 21

22 shall have the amount determined pursuant to subsection E of this
23 section, or the premium rate of the health insurance benefit plan,
24 whichever is less, paid by the Teachers' Retirement System of

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Oklahoma. If the amount paid by the Teachers' Retirement System of
 Oklahoma does not cover the full cost of the health insurance
 premium, the retired person shall pay the remaining amount if the
 retired person wants to continue the coverage.

D. The Teachers' Retirement System shall pay the amount due
pursuant to the provisions of subsection C of this section as
follows:

For those individuals participating in plans provided
 through the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act,
 payment shall be made to the Board pursuant to the provisions of
 subsection I of this section; or

For those individuals participating in plans provided
 through a participating education employer of the Teachers'
 Retirement System of Oklahoma other than a health insurance plan
 offered pursuant to the State and Education Employees Group
 Insurance Act, payment shall be made to the education employer.

E. Beginning July 1, 2000 2011, the maximum benefit payable by the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma on behalf of a retired person toward said person's monthly premium for health insurance shall be determined in accordance with the following schedule:

For plans offered by the State and Education Employees Group IA Insurance Board, the amount paid pursuant to this subsection shall first be applied to the prescription drug coverage premium, if any. Any remaining amounts shall be applied towards the medical coverage premium.

F. If a person retires and begins to receive benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma or terminates service and has a vested benefit with the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma, the person may elect, in the manner provided in subsection A of this section, to participate in the dental insurance plan offered through the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act. The person shall pay the full cost of the dental insurance.

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Those persons who are receiving benefits from the Teachers' 1 G. Retirement System of Oklahoma and have health insurance coverage 2 which on the operative date of this section is being paid by the 3 education entity from which the person retired shall make the 4 5 election required in subsection A of this section within thirty (30) days of the termination of said health insurance coverage. 6 The person making the election shall give the Board certified 7 documentation satisfactory to the Board of the termination date of 8 9 the other health insurance coverage.

10 н. Dependents of a deceased education employee who was on active work status or on a disability leave at the time of death or 11 12 of a participating retirant or of any person who has elected to 13 receive a vested benefit under the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma may continue the health and dental insurance benefits in 14 force provided said dependents pay the full cost of such insurance 15 and they were covered as eliqible dependents at the time of such 16 death and such election is made within thirty (30) days of date of 17 The eligibility for said benefits shall terminate for the 18 death. surviving children when said children cease to qualify as 19 dependents. 20

I. The amounts required to be paid by the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma pursuant to this section shall be forwarded no later than the tenth day of each month following the month for which payment is due by the Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement

System of Oklahoma to the State and Education Employees Group
 Insurance Board for deposit in the Education Employees Group
 Insurance Reserve Fund.

J. The Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma shall provide the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board information concerning the employers of retired and vested members necessary to allow the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board to track eligibility for continued coverage.

9 K. Upon retirement from employment with the Board of Regents of 10 the University of Oklahoma, any person who is or was employed at the George Nigh Rehabilitation Institute and who transferred employment 11 pursuant to Section 3427 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any 12 person who was employed at the Medical Technology and Research 13 Authority and who transferred employment pursuant to Section 7068 of 14 this title, and any person who is a member of the Oklahoma Law 15 Enforcement Retirement System pursuant to the authority of Section 16 2-314 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes may participate in the 17 benefits authorized by the provisions of the State and Education 18 Employees Group Insurance Act for retired participants, including 19 health, dental and life insurance benefits, if such election to 20 participate is made within thirty (30) days from the date of 21 termination of employment. Life insurance benefits for any such 22 person who transferred employment shall not exceed the coverage the 23 person had at the time of such transfer. Retirees who are persons 24

1	transferred employment and who participate pursuant to this
2	paragraph shall pay the premium for elected benefits less any
3	amounts paid by the retirement system pursuant to this section.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.
5	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
