5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to motor vehicles; creating Aaron's  
7 Law; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-903, as  
8 amended by Section 1, Chapter 164, O.S.L. 2005 (47  
9 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 11-903), which relates to  
negligent homicide; modifying penalties; providing  
for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 This act shall be known and may be cited as "Aaron's Law".

16 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-903, as  
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 164, O.S.L. 2005 (47 O.S. Supp. 2010,  
18 Section 11-903), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 11-903. A. When the death of any person ensues within  
20 one (1) year as a proximate result of injury received by the driving  
21 of any vehicle by any person in reckless disregard of the safety of  
22 others, the person so operating such vehicle shall be guilty of  
23 negligent homicide.

B. Any person convicted of negligent homicide shall be ~~punished~~  
guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the ~~county jail~~  
custody of the Department of Corrections for not ~~more~~ less than one  
(1) year or by fine of not less than ~~One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)~~  
~~nor more than~~ One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine  
and imprisonment.

C. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall revoke the license  
or permit to drive and any nonresident operating privilege of any  
person convicted of negligent homicide.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
