6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; creating the
8 Higher Education Faculty Accountability Act; stating
9 intent that higher education institutions require
10 certain faculty to maintain a minimum number of
teaching contact hours; providing for
noncodification; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Higher
17 Education Faculty Accountability Act".

18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3246 of Title 70, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that each
22 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education
23 shall implement a policy that requires after the effective date of
24 this act that every full-time faculty member maintain a minimum of

1 twenty (20) teaching contact hours per week during each semester
2 that the faculty member is employed on a full-time basis.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
