6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; establishing the
8 Oklahoma School Bus Alternative Fuels Conversion
9 Grant Program; directing the Oklahoma Department of
10 Commerce to award grants for certain purposes;
11 specifying use of grants; creating the Oklahoma
12 School Bus Alternative Fuels Conversion Grant
13 Revolving Fund; making the fund continuing; stating
14 source of funds; stating purpose; requiring
15 expenditures to be made upon warrants; providing for
16 codification; providing an effective date; and
17 declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.21 of Title 74, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 There is hereby established the Oklahoma School Bus Alternative
Fuels Conversion Grant Program. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce
shall award grants to school district for the purpose of converting
school buses to operate on an alternative fuel and to install
alternative fuel fill stations to service the school buses. The
grants shall cover the reasonable expenses of the conversion of the

1 school buses and the reasonable expenses of the installation of a
2 fill station.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.22 of Title 74, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
7 for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the
8 "Oklahoma School Bus Alternative Fuels Conversion Grant Revolving
9 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
10 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
11 Oklahoma Department of Commerce from appropriated monies and any
12 other monies designated for the fund. All monies accruing to the
13 credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
14 expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the purpose of
15 converting school buses to operate on an alternative fuel and to
16 install alternative fuel fill stations. Expenditures from said fund
17 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
18 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
19 State Finance for approval and payment.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

21 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
