HOUSE BILL 1635

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; amending 37 O.S. 2001, Section 518, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 2010 (37 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 518), which relates to license fees; reducing winemaking self-distribution license fee; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 2001, Section 518, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 2010 (37 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 518), is amended to read as follows:

Section 518. A. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the licenses issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission, and the annual fees therefor, shall be as follows:

- 1. Brewer License..... \$1,250.00
- 2. Oklahoma Brewer License..... \$125.00
- 3. Distiller License
 - a. For each fiscal year ending
 - after June 30, 2010..... \$3,125.00

15 There shall be added to the initial or renewal fees for a Mixed
16 Beverage License an administrative fee, which shall not be deemed to
17 be a license fee, in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00),
18 which shall be paid at the same time and in the same manner as the
19 license fees prescribed by paragraph 10 of this subsection;
20 provided, this fee shall not be assessed against service
21 organizations or fraternal beneficiary societies which are exempt
22 under Section 501(c) (19), (8) or (10) of the Internal Revenue Code.
23 There shall be added to the fee for a Mixed Beverage/Caterer
24 Combination License an administrative fee, which shall not be deemed

1 to be a license fee, in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars
2 (\$250.00), which shall be paid at the same time and in the same
3 manner as the license fee prescribed by paragraph 11 of this
4 subsection.

5 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this
6 section:

7 1. The license fee for a mixed beverage or bottle club license
8 for those service organizations or fraternal beneficiary societies
9 which are exempt under Section 501(c)(19), (8) or (10) of the
10 Internal Revenue Code shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per
11 year;

12 2. The fees provided for in subsection A of this section for a
13 brewer license and for a Class B wholesaler license shall be reduced
14 by seventy-five percent (75%) if the applicant therefor is also the
15 holder of a license to manufacture or wholesale any low-point beer
16 as provided for in this title; and

17 3. The renewal fee for an airline/railroad beverage license
18 held by a railroad described in 49 U.S.C., Section 24301, shall be
19 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

20 C. An applicant may apply for and receive both a beer and wine
21 license and a caterer license.

22 D. All licenses, except as otherwise provided, shall be valid
23 for one (1) year from date of issuance unless revoked or
24

1 surrendered. Provided, all employee licenses issued on or after
2 September 1, 1993, shall be valid for two (2) years.

3 E. The holder of a license, issued by the ABLE Commission, for
4 a bottle club located in a county of this state where the sale of
5 alcoholic beverages by the individual drink for on-premises
6 consumption has been authorized, may exchange the bottle club
7 license for a mixed beverage license or a beer and wine license and
8 operate the licensed premises as a mixed beverage establishment or a
9 beer and wine establishment subject to the provisions of the
10 Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. There shall be no
11 additional fee for such exchange and the mixed beverage license or
12 beer and wine license issued shall expire one (1) year from the date
13 of issuance of the original bottle club license.

14 F. In addition to the applicable licensing fee, the following
15 surcharge shall be assessed annually on the following licenses:

- 16 1. Nonresident Seller..... \$2,500.00
- 17 2. Wholesaler..... \$2,500.00
- 18 3. Class B Wholesaler without an active
19 low-point beer license..... \$1,000.00
- 20 4. Class B Wholesaler with an active low-point
21 beer license..... \$1,500.00
- 22 5. Package Store for cities and towns over 5,000
23 population..... \$250.00
- 24 6. Package Store for cities and towns from 2,501

- 1 to 5,000 population..... \$200.00
- 2 7. Package Store for cities and towns from 200 to
- 3 2,500 population..... \$150.00
- 4 8. Mixed Beverage..... \$25.00
- 5 9. Mixed Beverage/Caterer Combination..... \$25.00
- 6 10. Caterer..... \$25.00
- 7 11. Beer and Wine..... \$25.00

8 The surcharge shall be paid concurrent with the licensee's annual
9 licensing fee and shall be deposited in the ABLE Commission
10 Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 567 of this title.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
