6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; allowing
8 licensed practitioners to prescribe or dispense
9 controlled substances without federal license;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-312.2 of Title 63, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any licensed practitioner who elects not to have a United States
17 Drug Enforcement Agency license to prescribe or dispense controlled
18 substances shall not be compelled to obtain such license in order to
19 prescribe or dispense a controlled substance in Oklahoma, provided
20 the health care provider has been issued a registration to prescribe
21 or dispense controlled substances pursuant to Section 2-303 of Title
22 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
