6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 7001-1.1, as amended by Section 9, Chapter  
9 233, O.S.L. 2009, and as renumbered by Section 209,  
10 Chapter 233, O.S.L. 2009 (10A O.S. Supp. 2010,  
11 Section 1-1-101), which relates to the Children and  
12 Juvenile Code; clarifying language; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7001-1.1, as  
16 amended by Section 9, Chapter 233, O.S.L. 2009, and as renumbered by  
17 Section 209, Chapter 233, O.S.L. 2009 (10A O.S. Supp. 2010, Section  
18 1-1-101), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1-1-101. A. Sections 1-1-101 through 1-9-122 of this  
20 title shall be known ~~and may be cited~~ as the "Oklahoma Children's  
21 Code".

22 B. All statutes hereinafter enacted and codified in this title  
23 shall be considered and deemed part of the Oklahoma Children's Code.

24 C. Article, chapter, and part captions are part of the Oklahoma  
Children's Code, but shall not be deemed to govern, limit or in any

1 manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of any  
2 chapter or part of this Code.

3 D. The provisions of this article shall not apply to adoption  
4 proceedings and actions to terminate parental rights which do not  
5 involve a petition for deprived status of the child. Such  
6 proceedings and actions shall be governed by the Oklahoma Adoption  
7 Code.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
