6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 amending 19 O.S. 2001, Sections 180.63, as amended by  
9 Section 1, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 and 180.75, as  
10 amended by Section 2, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19  
11 O.S. Supp. 2010, Sections 180.63 and 180.75), which  
12 relate to basic salary increases for county officers;  
13 making certain increases discretionary; and providing  
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 180.63, as  
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010,  
18 Section 180.63), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 180.63 In every county in this state, the salary of all  
20 county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title  
21 ~~shall~~ may be increased from the applicable basic salary named in  
22 Section 180.62 of this title, for net valuation or serviceability,  
23 according to the following scale:

24 A. To the basic salary:

- 1           1.    Add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times  
2                    each One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) net  
3                    valuation, or major fraction thereof until a net  
4                    valuation of Seventy-five Million Dollars  
5                    (\$75,000,000.00) is reached;
- 6           2.    Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars  
7                    (\$100.00) times each additional Five Million Dollars  
8                    (\$5,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction  
9                    thereof until a net valuation of Five Hundred Million  
10                   Dollars (\$500,000,000.00) is reached;
- 11          3.    Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five  
12                   Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seven Million  
13                   Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) net valuation, or major  
14                   fraction thereof until a net valuation of Two Billion  
15                   Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) is reached;
- 16          4.    Thereafter as to all additional net valuation add the  
17                   product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00)  
18                   times each additional Twenty Million Dollars  
19                   (\$20,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction  
20                   thereof.

21           B.   And also the salary of each county officer shall be  
22    additionally increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.62  
23    of this title, and the additions thereto heretofore provided in this  
24

1 section, for population or service load according to the following  
2 scale:

- 3 1. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)  
4 times each one thousand (1,000) population, or major  
5 fraction thereof until a population of seventy-five  
6 thousand (75,000) is reached; thereafter
- 7 2. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)  
8 times each additional five thousand (5,000)  
9 population, or major fraction thereof until a  
10 population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) is  
11 reached; thereafter add
- 12 3. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)  
13 times each additional ten thousand (10,000)  
14 population, or major fraction thereof.

15 C. This section shall not reduce the present salary of any  
16 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 180.75, as  
18 amended by Section 2, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010,  
19 Section 180.75), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 180.75 A. In every county in this state which approves  
21 an exemption of household goods of the heads of families and  
22 livestock employed in support of the family from ad valorem taxation  
23 pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma  
24 Constitution, the salary of all county officers named in paragraph 1

1 of Section 180.73 of this title ~~shall~~ may be increased from the  
2 applicable basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this title, for  
3 the factor of service-ability, as defined in Section 180.71 of this  
4 title, according to the following scale:

5 1. To the basic salary:

6 a. add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times  
7 each Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) of revenue  
8 authorized to be collected for county purposes, or  
9 major fraction thereof until the amount of such  
10 revenue equals Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars  
11 (\$750,000.00),

12 b. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars  
13 (\$100.00) times each additional Fifty Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$50,000.00) of revenue authorized to be collected for  
15 county purposes, or major fraction thereof until the  
16 amount of such revenue equals Five Million Dollars  
17 (\$5,000,000.00),

18 c. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five  
19 Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seventy  
20 Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) of revenue authorized to  
21 be collected for county purposes, or major fraction  
22 thereof until the amount of such revenue equals Twenty  
23 Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00),

24

1           d.    thereafter as to all additional revenue which is  
2                    authorized to be collected for county purposes add the  
3                    product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00)  
4                    times each additional Two Hundred Thousand Dollars  
5                    (\$200,000.00) of such revenue, or major fraction  
6                    thereof; and

7           2.    The salary of each county officer shall be additionally  
8    increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this  
9    title, and the additions to the basic salary as provided in this  
10   section, for population or service load according to the following  
11   scale:

12           a.    the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)  
13                    times each one thousand (1,000) population, or major  
14                    fraction thereof until a population of seventy-five  
15                    thousand (75,000) is reached,

16           b.    thereafter the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty  
17                    cents (\$12.50) times each additional five thousand  
18                    (5,000) population, or major fraction thereof until a  
19                    population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) is  
20                    reached,

21           c.    thereafter add the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty  
22                    cents (\$12.50) times each additional ten thousand  
23                    (10,000) population, or major fraction thereof.

1 B. This section shall not reduce the present salary of any  
2 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office.

3 C. As used in this section, "major fraction thereof" means any  
4 amount greater than one-half (1/2).

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
