9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and  
11 Mathematics; making an appropriation to the Board of  
12 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and  
13 Mathematics; stating purpose; requiring expenditure  
14 of certain sum for certain purpose; requiring  
15 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
16 requiring performance measures; making certain  
17 students eligible for certain programs; requiring  
18 budgeting of certain funds in certain years;  
19 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget  
20 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;  
21 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
22 emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of  
Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any  
monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of  
the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the sum  
of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or so much

1 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
2 Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics  
3 by law.

4 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act  
5 and Section 35 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of  
6 the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Four Hundred  
7 Seventy-seven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-one Dollars  
8 (\$1,477,331.00) shall be expended for the purpose of developing and  
9 offering pilot outreach programs in science and mathematics as  
10 directed in Section 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

11 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the Board  
12 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall  
13 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

20 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance  
21 measures for each budget category.

22 SECTION 4. Students who are enrolled in a consolidated school  
23 district shall be eligible to apply to attend regional pilot  
24

1 outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section  
2 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes if all or part of the  
3 consolidated school district is served by the technology center  
4 school district.

5 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act and Section 35 of  
6 Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma  
7 Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay  
8 purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012  
9 (hereafter FY-12) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June  
10 30, 2013 (hereafter FY-13). Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be  
11 encumbered only through June 30, 2012, and must be expended by  
12 November 15, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, and  
13 not budgeted for FY-13, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund  
14 for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-13 may be  
15 encumbered only through June 30, 2013. Any funds remaining after  
16 November 15, 2013, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for  
17 the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be  
18 budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-  
19 12, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be  
20 budgeted for FY-13, after the agency to which the funds have been  
21 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
22 revision removing these funds from the FY-12 budget work program and  
23 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
24 Finance.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

2 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
