7 An Act relating to legislators; prohibiting
8 compensation, remuneration or reimbursement from
9 certain entities for prescribed period; providing
10 exception; providing for penalties; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 335 of Title 21, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Except as otherwise provided by subsection B of this
17 section, no former member of the Legislature shall be employed by or
18 receive any form of compensation, remuneration or expense
19 reimbursement from any state agency, political subdivision, or other
20 governmental entity for a period of two (2) years after the end of
21 the term to which the member was elected.

22 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
23 apply to a former member employed by a state agency, political
24 subdivision, or other governmental entity if the compensation for

1 employment does not exceed the former member's base legislative
2 salary for the two (2) years after the end of the term to which the
3 member was elected.

4 C. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
5 section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more
6 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment in the
7 custody of the Department of Corrections not exceeding two (2)
8 years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
